



## Update on Noise Assessment July 3<sup>th</sup> 2025

As part of our ongoing commitment to address community concerns about an increase in noise near The Clemow, an Ottawa bylaw officer visited the area earlier today.

The officer assessed a nearby property where a resident reported increased noise since The Clemow's cooling system began running. Measurements were taken with the cooling system both on and off to determine its impact on local noise levels.

Once we receive the city's official report, we will share the findings with residents and inform them of the next steps.

In addition to the city's assessment, an independent sound consultant from Gradient Wind Engineering has started a more extensive review. This includes taking measurements on Clemow and Powell, both west and east of Bronson, as well as on the Avenues, in response to requests from Glebe residents.

We have provided our contact information to Councillor Menard's office to share with residents who wish to discuss their concerns directly, and we welcome the opportunity to engage with our neighbours.

We remain committed to fully complying with the city's noise bylaws and being a respectful member of the community.
